In line with our values and our vision, MMG is committed to the safe, socially and environmentally responsible operation of our assets.

This Policy provides a framework which empowers our people to make decisions on behalf of MMG.

MMG's Safety, Security, Health, Environment and Community Policy principles are:

- Compliance with all applicable legal requirements and delivery on our voluntary commitments;
- Effective leadership to drive a culture of zero fatalities and personal safety accountability;
- Proactively identifying and managing material risks to prevent injury and ill health to our people, minimise negative impacts on the environment, and manage social risk in our host communities;
- Balancing our use of natural resources with other social and ecological needs;
- Engaging with interested and affected parties in relation to SSHEC impacts and our management response;
- Working with communities, governments and other stakeholders to effectively contribute to social and economic development where we operate;
- Providing security management and commitment to protect our people, assets and environment, including the prevention of pollution, while respecting human rights;
- Building SSHEC competence and capability in employees and contractors, to effectively deliver on our organisational objectives;
- Disseminating relevant SSHEC information to employees, contractors and other external parties;
- Setting realistic and measurable objectives and targets, as part of integrated business planning, to drive continuous improvement in SSHEC performance;
- Reporting on our SSHEC performance in a manner that is balanced, comparable and accurate; and
- Committing to continuous improvement to enhance our SSHEC performance.

This Policy is supported by MMG Standards, MMG Frameworks and processes that prescribe and define the way MMG operates.
